The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling
 - a. Revise the Environmental Hazards statement to read:

Environmental Hazards

This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans, or public waters unless this product is specifically identified and addressed in an NPDES permit. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the sewage treatment plant authority.

- b. Delete the word "milk" from the Statement of Practical Treatment.
- c. Place the statement "Avoid contamination of food" after "Harmful If Swallowed."

- d. Delete "Water (H₂O)" from the ingredient statement. If you wish to include inerts on your product label, you must list them all.
 - e. Delete the statement "Non-flammable, non-volatile and odorless" from the front panel.
 - f. The signal word "DANGER" must be placed directly below the statement "Keep Out of Reach of Children."
 - g. The heading "Directions for Use. It is a violation of Federal law . . ." must be placed before your actual use directions [i.e., for (open system) recirculating]
2. The revised Confidential Statement of Formula is acceptable.
 3. All alternate sources of supply for the active ingredients in the formulation are acceptable.


Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

Concentrated Slimicide is compatible with virtually all corrosion inhibition additives, but should not be used in the presence of soap and other anionic detergents.

This product at use dilution is non-corrosive to man-made surfaces.

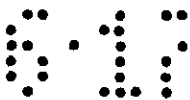
