The labeling amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, As Amended (FIFRA), is acceptable, provided that you:

Submit two copies of your final printed label incorporating the following correction before you release the product for shipment.

The following statement is not appropriate for a product registered under FIFRA for use as a pesticide and must be removed from the label: "No warranty, express or implied, of merchantability, fitness or otherwise is made."

This statement is considered misleading in that it detracts from and possibly even negates label claims that the product is efficacious for the uses set forth on the label if the directions for use are followed. Refer to FIFRA, sec. 2(q)(1) and 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) regarding false or



CAUTION

HARMFUL IF INHALED, SWALLOWED OR ABSORBED THROUGH THE SKIN. Avoid breathing spray mist. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, and clothing. Store away from children and domestic animals. Avoid contact with food and feedstuffs.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN- Contains petroleum distillate - vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia. Contains organophosphate that inhibits cholinesterase.	

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This pesticide is toxic to fish, aquatic invertebrates, and aquatic life stages of amphibians. Do not apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Drift and runoff may be hazardous to aquatic organisms in areas near the application site. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters.

This product is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment on blooming crops or weeds. Do not apply this product or allow it to drift to blooming crops or weeds if bees are visiting the treatment area.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Outdoor for temporary relief from the annoyance of mosquitoes, flies and certain other small flying insects. Spray or fog at the rate of 48 gallons per hour at a maximum vehicle speed of 5 M.P.H.; for hand equipment, apply by walking at a moderate pace. Wind should not be greater than 5 M.P.H. For optimum results apply early in the morning when conditions are favorable and when temperatures are expected to go above 65°F.

Apply .5 to 2.5 gallons of Malathion Fogging Concentrate per acre.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.

STORAGE: If container is damaged, stop any leaks by repositioning the container or by patching or otherwise repairing the leaks. Take care to avoid contact with pesticide and wear protective gear. On cleanup of spilled liquids, wear protective equipment as required to prevent contact with the product or its vapors. Cover the spilled areas with generous amounts of absorbent material, such as clay, diatomaceous earth, sand or sawdust. Sweep the contaminated absorbent on to a shovel and put the sweepings into a salvage drum. Dispose of the wastes as below. Place any leaking container into a similar drum or glass container. Do not store, use, pour or spill near heat or open flame.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: METAL CONTAINERS: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities. **PLASTIC CONTAINERS:** Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration, or if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
