

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling

DISINFECTION

Use at 2 ounces per gallon. This product will be effective against *Pseudomonas aeruginosa* PRD-10 at this level. This has been substantiated by the AOAC Use Dilution Confirmation Test. At this level the product is fungicidal against pathogenic fungi.

For best results use O-DIS 27-42 with a cloth or mop and apply to walls, floors and other hard surfaces.

For heavily soiled areas a preliminary cleaning is required. Thoroughly wet all surfaces. Treated surfaces must remain wet for 10 minutes. Fresh solution should be prepared daily or when the use solution becomes visibly dirty.

SANITATION

Thoroughly wet all surfaces. Treated surfaces must remain wet for 1 minute. Fresh solution should be prepared daily or when the use solution becomes visibly dirty. For mechanical applications use solution may not be reused for sanitizing applications.

It is used for sanitization of previously cleaned or food contact items limit the level of active quaternaries to 200 ppm (2.8 ounces per 5 gallons). For heavily soiled or organic matter, a pre-cleaning step is required.

Drain food particles and soil must be removed by a pre-rinse, pre-scrape, or pre-soak treatment.
All surfaces must be thoroughly washed with a good detergent and rinsed with potable water before sanitizing solution is used.

This product when used on environmental inanimate hard surfaces at 2 ounces per gallon of water is effective against Influenza A2, Herpes Simplex, Adenovirus type 2 and Vaccinia viruses.

Rinse empty containers thoroughly with water and discard.

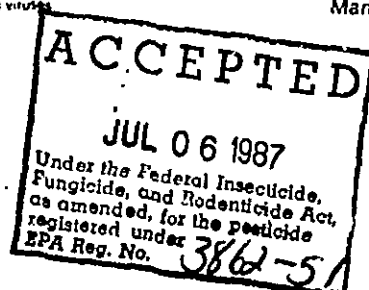

O-DIS 27-42 can provide the assurance you need in this area when used as directed. For use on floors, walls, sinks, toilets, garbage pails, telephones, rest rooms, bed pans and operating rooms. Effective against *Staphylococcus aureus*, *Salmonella choleraesuis* and *Pseudomonas aeruginosa*. Also effective against pathogenic fungi, *Trichophyton interdigitale*.

When used for sanitization of previously cleaned food processing equipment and food contact items limit the active quaternaries to 200 ppm. After using this compound sanitized food surfaces must be thoroughly rinsed with potable water.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

DANGER

Keep Out of Reach of Children. Corrosive. Causes severe eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Handle with care. Avoid contamination of food.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

In case of contact immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. If eyes call a physician. Remove and wash all contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed drink milk, egg whites, gelatin solution, or if these are not available drink large quantities of water. Call a physician.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not reuse container. Rinse thoroughly before discarding in trash. Store in dry place no lower in temperature than 50°F or higher than 120°F.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.
