DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

1. Adjust water pH to 7.2-7.6 as determined by a test kit. For pools with copper plumbing, the best pH factor is 7.6-7.8.
2. If the pool has not been previously stabilized, add conditioner/stabilizer (cyanuric acid). Follow the directions or the label of those products.
3. Adjust and maintain the total alkalinity between 80-120 ppm as determined by a suitable test kit.
4. In a newly filled pool, follow steps 1 through 3 and then superchlorinate the pool using an appropriate shock treatment to establish a chlorine residual of 1.0-3.0 ppm.
5. For daily maintenance add 2.0 oz. (one tablet) per 10,000 gallons of pool water. Add tablets in pool skimmer or use a floating chlorinating tablet dispenser.
6. It may be necessary to periodically shock (superchlorinate) the pool water. If there is a heavy bather load, the chlorine residual slips below 0.2 ppm, algae appears, or there is a burning sensation to the eyes, or after a heavy rain, shock the pool as in step 4 (above).
7. At all times maintain a free chlorine residual of between 1 and 3 ppm as determined by a suitable test kit.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Keep product dry in a tightly closed container when not in use. Store in a cool, dry well ventilated area away from heat or open flame. In case of decomposition, isolate container in an open area if possible and flood with large amounts of water. Do not reuse empty container. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water to dissolve all material before discarding. Place in trash collection or dispose in approved landfill area.
