GENERAL USE DIRECTIONS FOR DISINFECTING:

For use on hard pre-cleaned

non-porous surfaces such as floors, walls, metal surfaces, porcelain, and plastic surfaces

in institutions, schools, and hospitals. Remove gross

fith and heavy soil deposits then thoroughly wet surfaces as recommended and required. Use 1/2 ounce per gallon of water for a minimum contact time of 10 minutes in a single application. Can be applied with a mop, sponge, or cloth as well as spraying or soaking. The recommended use solution is prepared fresh for each use then discarded. Rinsing is not necessary unless floors are to be waxed or polished.

FOR SANITIZING: *pre-cleaned*

For use on hard, non-porous surfaces such as chopping blocks, counter tops, eating utensils, and drinking glasses. For heavily soiled areas a pre-cleaning is recommended and required. Then use 1/2 ounce per 3 gallons of water for a minimum contact time of 1 minute in a single application. Can be applied with a mop, sponge, or cloth as well as spraying or soaking. The recommended use solution is prepared fresh for each use then discarded. Do not rinse.

Before use as a sanitizer in federally inspected meat and poultry plants, and dairies, food products and packaging materials must be removed from the room or carefully protected. A potable water rinse is not required following use of this compound on previously cleaned hard surfaces provided that the surfaces are adequately drained before contact with food so that little or no residue remains.

Pasteurized and Bulk Use. For use as a sanitizer on dishes, glassware, silverware, cooking utensils, wash with detergent, thoroughly and immerse in a solution (1/2 ounce per 3 gallons of water) for at least 1 minute. Do not rinse.
