

GENERAL INFORMATION

For total weed control on certain areas around the business or workplace where no plant growth is desired use as specified in label directions.
Controls bindweed, common mullein, and other hard-to-kill weeds
Prevents plant growth for up to one year.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. For control of annual and broadleaf weeds such as downy brome grass, oat grass, goose grass, quack grass, puncture vine, goldenrod, plantain, bindweed, johnson grass, common mullein and wild carrot. To cover 100 sq. ft., add 10 - 15 2/3 fl. oz. by use of a sprinkling can or other watering or spraying device in sufficient water to get good coverage of the area (e.g., 2 1/2 gals. in sprinkling can). Different grades of mineral oil, diesel fuel, petroleum-based-oil, fuel oil, or kerosene may be substituted for water.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.
PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store at temperatures above 32 deg. F. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Keep container closed when not in use.
PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal law.
