Directions: remove protective cap. Hold dispenser upright and press button to release fog. For control of flying and crawling insects listed below in closed rooms, offices, warehouses, barns, and for temporary control in outdoor sheltered areas, patios, and porches apply as follows.

FLYING INSECTS: Flies, mosquitoes, wasps, flying moths, gnats: Shut door and windows and spray up into air with a sweeping motion so to fill the room with spray mists. Keep room closed for at least fifteen minutes after spraying.

CRAWLING INSECTS: Roaches, silverfish, waterbugs, crickets: spray hiding places such as baseboards, openings around sinks, drains and pipes. Also secluded places. Spray directly on these insects whenever possible. Repeat as needed. **SPIDERS AND CENTIPEDES:** Spray webs and other places where these pests crawl. Spray directly on as many of these insects as possible. Repeat as needed.

CAUTION: Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using. When using the product in these areas, apply only when the facility is not in operation.

PHYSICAL & CHEMICAL HAZARDS
STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal. **STORAGE:** Contents under pressure. **FLAMMABLE.** Keep away from fire, sparks, and heated surfaces. Exposure to temperatures above 120°F may cause bursting. Keep out of reach of children. **DISPOSAL:** Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture. Wastes resulting from the end use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.
