Dear Mr. Rekhelman;

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Five copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

1. In accordance with PR Notice 97-6, you may change the term "Inert Ingredients" at the bottom of the Ingredient statement to "Other Ingredients."
2. Page 2 within the Directions for use for granary weevil, rice weevil, confused flour beetle, rust red flour beetle,....." correct the typographical errors for "Rust Red Flour **Beelte**" to "Rust Red Flour Beetle". Within the statement "Wet surfaces thoroughly and treat all infested surface ares.", correct the "ares" to "**areas**."
3. Within the section entitled "Physical or Chemical Hazards" modify the statement "Do not apply this product in or on equipment due to the possibility of a shock hazard." to "**Do not apply this product around electrical equipment due to the possibility of shock hazard.**"

4. The Environmental Hazards section. DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not apply directly to food. Do not apply while food processing is underway. Remove pets and bird cages and remove or cover fishbowls before spray application.

Exposed edible products and their packaging materials must be removed, tightly covered, or stored in closed containers before spraying. Facilities and equipment must be thoroughly washed with an effective cleaning compound and rinsed with potable water after spraying.

FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS: Close room and discharge mist vigorously in all parts of room, using 1/2 to 1 ounce for each 1000 cubic feet of space. Leave room closed for at least ten minutes. Do not remain in closed treated area. Ventilate when treatment is completed. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects. Repeat as needed.

FLEAS (INFESTING PREMISES): Remove and destroy animals' bedding and spray sleeping quarters freely, forcing the spray into all cracks in the floor and about the room. Repeat when reinfested.

ROACHES, WATERBUGS: Apply in all cracks and crevices in woodwork, underneath sinks, dark places behind pipes, and in all places where roaches and waterbugs infest, contacting as many insects as possible. Repeat the operation as often as necessary.

CLOTHES MOTHS, CARPET BEETLES: Spray all articles to be protected, giving particular attention to folds and seams. Interior surfaces should be sprayed regularly. The treatment should be repeated every 30 days unless the articles are stored in moth-tight containers.

GRANARY WEEVIL, RICE WEEVIL, CONFUSED FLOUR BEETLE, RUST RED FLOUR BEETLE, SAW-TOOTHED GRAIN BEETLE, CIGARETTE BEETLE, DRUG STORE BEETLE, CADELLES, GRAIN MITES (Accessible Stages): Wet surfaces thoroughly and treat all infested surface areas, insect runways and hiding places at the rate of 1/2 gallon of this material to 1000 square feet of area, or to the point of run-off. Repeat when necessary. Do not treat stored grain with this product.

This spray is especially designed for use in cafes, restaurants, food storage warehouses, flour mills, meat packing plants and the like. This spray is designed for use in either fogging equipment or hand sprayers.
