NOTE: This product is not being reregistered under sections 3(c)5 and 4(g) of FIFRA at this time.

Please be reminded that 40 CFR Part 156.140(a)(4) requires that a batch code, lot number, or other code identifying the batch of the pesticide distributed and sold be placed on non-refillable containers. The code may appear either on the label or durably marked on the container itself, and can be added by non-notification per PRN 98-10.

Please note that the record for this product currently contains the Confidential Statements of Formulation (CSFs) listed below. Any previously dated CSFs are superseded.



DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.
Not for Residential Use.

This spray is especially designed for use in cafes, restaurants, food storage warehouses, flour mills, meat packing plants and the like. This spray is designed for use in either fogging equipment or hand sprayers.

INDOOR FOOD HANDLING/PROCESSING FACILITIES:

Surface applications: use 19 ozs of this product per 1000 square feet of area. Crack/crevice or spot applications: use 1/2 gallon per 1000 square feet of area. Space sprays: use 1/2 to 1 oz per 1000 cubic feet of space.

USE RESTRICTION: do not apply more than 1 time per day.

COMMERCIAL AND INSTITUTIONAL INDOOR SITES:

Surface applications: use 19 ozs of this product per 1000 square feet of area. Crack/crevice or spot applications: use 1/2 gallon per 1000 square feet of area. Space sprays: use 1/2 to 1 oz per 1000 cubic feet of space.

USE ON FOOD STORED IN BAGS:

Space sprays may be made to the surfaces of bags of stored food products at the rate of 1/2 to 1 oz of this product per 1000 cubic feet of space.

USE RESTRICTION: DIRECT APPLICATION TO FOOD CONTACT SURFACES IS PROHIBITED.

Do not enter or allow others to enter until sprays have dried. Do not allow adults, children, or pets to enter the treated area for at least 15 minutes, until vapors, mists, and aerosols have dispersed, and the treated area has been thoroughly ventilated. Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or others persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application. Do not remain in treated area. Exit area immediately and remain outside the treated area until aerosols, vapors, and/or mists have dispersed. Do not make space spray applications when facility is in operation. Prior to space spray applications, cover or remove food. Prior to space spray applications, cover food processing surfaces or clean after treatment and before use.

FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS: Close room and discharge mist vigorously in all parts of room. Leave room closed for at least ten minutes. Do not remain in closed treated area. Ventilate when treatment is completed. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects. Repeat as needed.

FLEAS (INFESTING PREMISES): Remove and destroy animals' bedding and spray sleeping quarters freely, forcing the spray into all cracks in the floor and about the room. Repeat when reinfested.

ROACHES, WATERBUGS: Apply in all cracks and crevices in woodwork, underneath sinks, dark places behind pipes, and in all places where roaches and waterbugs infest, contacting as many insects as possible. Repeat the operation as often as necessary.

CLOTHES MOTHS, CARPET BEETLES: Spray all articles to be protected, giving particular attention to folds and seams. Interior surfaces should be sprayed regularly. The treatment should be repeated every 30 days unless the articles are stored in moth-tight containers.

GRANARY WEEVIL, RICE WEEVIL, CONFUSED FLOUR BEETLE, RUST RED FLOUR BEETLE, SAW-TOOTHED GRAIN BEETLE, CIGARETTE BEETLE, DRUG STORE BEETLE, CADELLES, GRAIN MITES (Accessible Stages): Wet surfaces thoroughly and treat all infested surface areas, insect runways and hiding places. Repeat when necessary. Do not treat stored grain with this product.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Do not store at temperatures below 32°F. Store only in original container.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Offer for recycling if available.
