The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is accepted subject to the comments listed below.

1. You must add the phrase, "FOR OUTDOOR USE ONLY" to the front panel of the labeling.
2. Please delete the word, "Etc.," from the front label panel.
3. In the Hazards to Humans and Animals section, please delete the following statement which begins as, "In case... plenty of water."

This statement is already contained in the Statement of Practical Treatment and does not need to be repeated.

4. Please revise your disposal statement to read as follows:

"Replace cap and wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture."

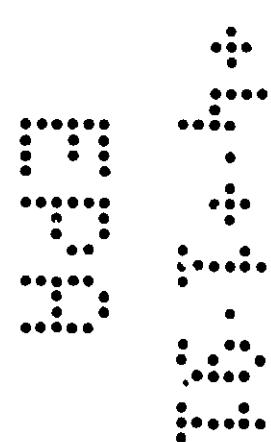

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Remove contaminated clothing and wash before re-use. Wash skin with soap and warm water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Do not induce vomiting because of aspiration pneumonia hazard.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: BAYGON is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Treat symptomatically. Atropine only by injection is an antidote.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

CAUTION

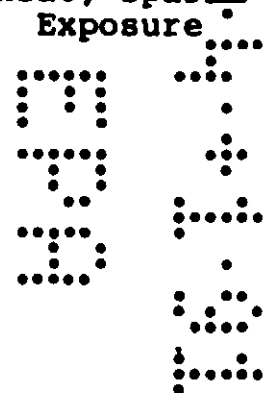
Harmful if swallowed. Contains petroleum distillate. Do not induce vomiting because of aspiration pneumonia hazard. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin or eyes. In case of contact, flush with plenty of water. Wash with soap and warm water after use. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists. Avoid contamination of food or feedstuffs.

Do not use in commercial food processing, preparation, food storage or serving areas. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment, or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food should be covered or removed.

Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

FLAMMABLE. Contents under pressure. Keep away from heat, sparks, open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 120 F may cause bursting.



DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FOR CONTROL FOR WASPS AND HORNETS: Apply after dark when all of the insects have returned to the nest. Aim valve opening at nest and depress button soaking the nest with spray. Repeat as necessary. Avoid wetting vegetation as it will be damaged. Do not use as a space spray.

OTHER USES-OUTDOORS ONLY: For control of Ants, Clover Mites, Crickets, Earwigs, Fleas, Millipedes, Sowbugs and Brown Dog Ticks: Spray infested areas thoroughly including outside surfaces of screen frames, doors, window frames, foundations, patios of other places where insects may enter or harbour. For ants, spray hills and runway. Repeat as necessary. Do not spray vegetation. Do not use as a space spray.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in a cool dry area away from heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL: Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
