The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the reregistration of the above referenced product in connection with the pyrethrins and PBO REDs, and has concluded that your submission is acceptable.

NOTE: This product is **not** being reregistered under sections 3(c)5 and 4(g) of FIFRA at this time.

Please be reminded that 40 CFR Part 156.140(a)(4) requires that a batch code, lot number, or other code identifying the batch of the pesticide distributed and sold be placed on non-refillable containers. The code may appear either on the label or durably marked on the container itself, and can be added by non-notification per PRN 98-10.

Please note that the record for this product currently contains the Confidential Statements of Formulation (CSFs) listed below. Any previously dated CSFs are superseded.

A copy of your label stamped "Accepted" is enclosed along with copies of the acute toxicity and product chemistry reviews completed for the subject product. Products shipped



after 12 months from the date of this amendment or the next printing of the label whichever occurs first, must bear the new revised label. **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**USE RESTRICTIONS**

Do not enter or allow others to enter until sprays have dried. Do not allow adults, children, or pets to enter the treated area for at least 15 minutes, until vapors, mists, and aerosols have dispersed, and the treated area has been thoroughly ventilated. Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or others persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application. Do not remain in treated area. Exit area immediately and remain outside the treated area until aerosols, vapors, and/or mists have dispersed. Do not make space spray applications when facility is in operation. Prior to space spray applications, cover or remove food. Prior to space spray applications, cover food processing surfaces or clean after treatment and before use. Do not apply more than 1 time per day. Do not wet articles to point of runoff or drip. Do not use treated articles until spray has dried. Dry clean treated clothes before wearing. Remove or cover exposed food and drinking water before application. Remove or cover dishes, utensils, food processing equipment, and food preparation surfaces, or wash them before use. When used in dairy barns or facilities: Close milk bulk tanks to prevent contamination from spray and from dead or falling insects. Remove or cover milk utensils before application. Wash teats of animals before milking. Do not use in aircraft cabins. Do not apply directly into sewers or drains, or to any area like a gutter where drainage to storm sewers, water bodies, or aquatic habitat can occur. Do not allow the product to enter any drain during or after application.

**SHAKE BEFORE USING AND AT INTERVALS DURING PROLONGED USE.** Hold container upright with nozzle away from you. Press valve down and spray as directed. To avoid possible staining of fabrics or surfaces, do not spray at close range. **Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Wasps, and Flying Moths (Millers):** Close all doors and windows and spray room at the rate of 1 second per 1000 cubic feet. Direct spray to all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources which attract these insects. Keep nozzle in constant motion. Keep room closed for 10 to 15 minutes after treatment. Repeat treatment as necessary. **Roaches, Waterbugs, Silverfish, Crickets, Spiders, Centipedes, and Sow Bugs:** Spray into hiding places such as cracks and crevices, behind sinks, cabinets, along baseboards and floors, whenever possible. Repeat treatment as necessary. **Ants:** Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary. **Indian Meal Moths and Angoumois Grain Moths:** Close doors and windows. Direct spray into all parts of room especially around stored food product container, pallets and darkened areas. Spray 7 to 10 seconds for each 1000 cubic feet of space. Keep area closed for 15 minutes following treatment. Repeat application weekly or as needed.

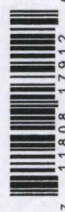
