Dear Mr. Rekhelman:

The amended label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. This approval does not affect any conditions that were previously imposed on this registration. You continue to be subject to existing conditions on your registration and any deadlines connected with them.

A stamped copy of your labeling is enclosed for your records. This labeling supersedes all previously accepted labeling. You must submit one copy of the final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the new labeling. In accordance with 40 CFR 152.130(c), you may distribute or sell this product under the previously approved labeling for 18 months from the date of this letter. After 18 months, you may only distribute or sell this product if it bears this new revised labeling or subsequently approved labeling. “To distribute or sell” is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 CFR 152.3.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company’s website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) list examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product’s label, claims made on the website may not substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. Therefore, should the Agency find or if it is brought to our attention that a website contains false or misleading statements or claims substantially differing from the EPA approved registration, the website will be referred to the EPA’s Office of Enforcement and Compliance.

Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

USE RESTRICTIONS

For indoor use only

Do not enter or allow others to enter until sprays have dried. Do not allow adults, children, or pets to enter the treated area for at least 15 minutes, until vapors, mists, and aerosols have been dispersed, and the treated area has been thoroughly ventilated. Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application. Do not remain in treated area. Exit area immediately and remain outside the treated area until aerosols, vapors, and/or mists have dispersed. Do not make space spray applications when facility is in operation. Prior to space spray applications, cover or remove food. Prior to space spray applications, cover food processing surfaces or clean after treatment and before use. Do not apply more than 1 time per day. Do not wet articles to point of runoff or drip. Do not use treated articles until spray has dried. Dry clean treated clothes before wearing. Remove or cover exposed food and drinking water before application. Remove or cover dishes, utensils, food processing equipment, and food preparation surfaces, or wash them before use. When used in dairy barns or facilities: Close milk lids to prevent contamination from spray and from dead or falling insects. Remove or cover milk utensils before application. Wash teats of animals before milking. Do not use in aircraft cabins. Do not apply directly into sewers or drains, or to any area like a gutter where drainage to storm sewers, water bodies, or aquatic habitat can occur. Do not allow the product to enter any drain during or after application.

SHAKE BEFORE USING AND AT INTERVALS DURING PROLONGED USE.

Hold container upright with nozzle away from you. Press valve down and spray as directed. To avoid possible staining of fabrics or surfaces, do not spray at close range. **Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Wasps, and Flying Moths (Millers):** Close all doors and windows and spray room at the rate of 1 second per 1000 cubic feet. Direct spray to all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources which attract these insects. Keep nozzles in constant motion. Keep room closed for 10 to 15 minutes after treatment. Repeat treatment as necessary. **Roaches, Waterbugs, Silverfish, Crickets, Spiders, Centipedes, and Sow Bugs:** Spray into hiding places such as cracks and crevices, behind sinks, cabinets, along baseboards and floors, whenever possible. Repeat treatment as necessary. **Ants:** Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary. **Indian Meal Moths and Angoumois Grain Moths:** Close doors and windows. Direct spray into all parts of room especially around stored food product container, pallets and dented areas. Spray 7 to 10 seconds for each 1000 cubic feet of space. Keep area closed for 15 minutes following treatment. Repeat application weekly or as needed.

Carpet Beetles: Spray directly on beetles, baseboards, floors, shelves and carpets. Repeat treatment as necessary. **Confused Flour Beetles, Saw-toothed Grain Beetles, Granary Weevils, Rice Weevils, Red Flour Beetles, Grain Mites:** Spray into cracks and crevices, processing and handling equipment, around cartons or containers and other areas where these insects tend to congregate. Spray 30 seconds for each 100 square feet of surface. Keep area closed for 45 minutes to 1 hour after treatment. Repeat application as necessary. **For mattresses, furniture and carpeting:** Direct spray into all folds, tufts, seams and crevices of infested areas until moist. Allow all treated surfaces to dry completely before use. **Bedbugs:** Spray mattresses, particularly around tufts and seams. Take beds apart and spray into all joints. Treat baseboards, moldings and frames. Repeat treatment as necessary. **Fleas:** Spray sleeping quarters, bedding, floor and floor covering where pets are kept. Repeat as necessary. Use only a recommended pet spray on pets.
