Amendment - Updating First Aid Statement per PR Notice 2001-1.

Dear Mr. Rekhelman:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Two (2) copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

- 1. Replace "Inert Ingredients" with the phrase "Other Ingredients".
- 2. Since this is a ready to use indoor total release aerosol product you may delete Environmental Hazards paragraph.
- 3. Delete "In case of contact, flush with plenty of water. Wash with soap and warm water after use. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists" from the Precautionary Statements. These statements are covered under first aid section.
- 4. Add "Cause moderate eye irritation. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling" to the Hazards to humans and domestic animals paragraph.
- 5. Replace "Avoid contact with skin or eyes" with "Avoid contact with skin. eyes or clothing"
- 6. Revise Disposal statement as follows:

Do Not Puncture or Incinerate!

If empty: Place in trash or offer for recycling if available.

If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency or [toll free number which meets the criteria in paragraph II.E. of PR Notice 2001-6] for disposal instructions.

7. Under directions for use delete, "Use additional units for remote rooms or where free flow of mist is not assured" and "Do not use more than one unit per average size room". These statements are in conflict with the statement, "Do not use more than one fogger per room."

X 5 ft. or smaller: instead allow log to enter from other rooms Turn off ALL ignition sources such as pilot lights (shut off gas valves), other open flames or running electrical appliances that cycle off and on (i.e., refrigerators thermostats etc.) Call your gas utility or management company if you need assistance with your pilot lights.
