Do not use in aircraft cabins. Do not allow adults, children, or pets to enter the treated area, until vapors, mists, and aerosols have dispersed, and the treated area has been thoroughly ventilated. Avoid contamination of food or feedstuffs.

Place a chair, small table or stand in the center of the room to be treated and cover with newspaper.

Cover wood floors and wood furniture in the immediate area around fogger with newspapers or a drop cloth. Open cabinets. cupboards, drawers, closets and doors in areas to be treated.

To Start Fogging: Immediately before activating fogger complete the door hang tag by filling in the time and date to instruct people not to enter the premises for at least two (4) hours from the activation time. Hang the tag on the door to the entrance. Point fogger away from face and eyes when releasing (container sprays straight up). To lock valve in open position for automatic discharge, press valve button down firmly, until it snaps into place. Then place the fogger on the stand or table in the center of the room.

Vacate the treated house, individual apartment unit or other structure immediately. Keep treated area closed for two (2) hours. Do not remain in the area during treatment.
