The following amendment, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable with the conditions listed below:

Proposed Amendment

- Update First Aid Statements per PR Notice 2001-1

Conditions

Revise the label as follows:

1. Revise the Precautionary Statements to read:

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS
DANGER**

Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage and skin burns. Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. Do not breathe vapor or fumes. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing.

Wear goggles or face shield, rubber gloves, and protective clothing when handling. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse.

2. Use sites must be specific. Delete the phrases "...and other commercial and institutional establishments." and "...and other hard non-porous surfaces." as these statements are too broad.
3. Revise the If On Skin section to read:

If on skin or clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

4. Revise the statement "**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL** Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage disposal. Do not store on side. Avoid creasing or impacting of side walls." to read:

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Do not store on side. Avoid creasing or impacting of side walls.


5. The ingredient statement must total 100%.

Corrosive. Keep Out of Reach of Children. Causes eye and skin damage (or skin irritation); produces chemical burns.
Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Do not breathe vapor or fumes. May be harmful or fatal if swallowed.

Lift Out is a one-step foamy cleaner-disinfectant containing a blend of phosphoric and hydroxy acetic acids for efficient removal of lime, soap scum, hard water deposits, uric acid salts, various discolorations from toilet bowls, urinals, shower stalls, ceramic tiles and sinks. Effective against *Staphylococcus aureus*, *Pseudomonas aeruginosa*, and *Salmonella choleraesuis* in the presence of 5% organic serum when tested according to AOAC Germicidal Spray Products Disinfectant Method. FOR CLEANING AND DISINFECTING TUBS, SINKS, SHOWER STALLS AND OTHER HARD NON-POROUS SURFACES:

1. Remove gross filth and heavy soil deposits.
2. Direct a coarse spray onto surface for 10 seconds from a distance of about 12 inches.
3. Allow foam to wet surface for 10 minutes.
4. Rinse surfaces thoroughly with water.

FOR GENERAL CLEANING AND DEODORIZING of hard non-porous surfaces: Dilute up to 1:10 with water and apply with a mop, sponge, cloth, or a trigger sprayer. Rinse thoroughly with water.
