Dear Ms. Inman,

The following amendment submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable with the conditions listed below.

- Response to Agency letter dated February 9, 2004

Conditions

Revise the label as follows:

1. Since your product is a limited disinfectant which cannot be used in hospitals, delete the term, "institutional" from the phrase, "For Commercial/Industrial/Institutional Use Only."
2. As the last statement in step 2 of the "Disinfection" directions, add the statement, "Wipe dry with cloth, sponge or mop or allow to air dry."
3. The Agency has asked registrants to begin submitting "Master" labels which contain all the claims, use sites, directions, storage/disposal statements, and environmental hazard statements on one label. You should revise your label to bring it into compliance with the above criteria for a "master label by bringing the label in compliance with PR Notice 84-1. Revise the label by adding the following text:

(Containers less than 1 gallon)

Storage and Disposal

Store in original container in areas inaccessible to children. Do not store on side. Avoid creasing or impacting of the side walls. Do not reuse the container. Wrap container and put in the trash.

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The Storage and Disposal language on the label should be preceded by the following text (Containers greater than 1 gallon)

Please Note: When you are packaging your product for distribution, you do not have to carry both Storage/Disposal Statements. They are applicable to specific container size being packaged.

To clean and deodorize hard surfaces, squeeze directly on surface or on wet cloth, sponge or brush. Loosen soil with agitation. Rinse with water. For a bright shine, polish with soft dry cloth. On stainless steel, rub with grain.

Use only on hard nonporous surfaces not harmed by mild abrasives, such as sinks, bathtubs, fiberglass bathtubs and shower enclosures, urinals, exterior toilet surfaces, drinking fountains, bathroom fixtures such as faucets and handles, glazed porcelain, metal, enamel, stainless steel, rubber, plastic, chrome, glazed ceramic tile, formica. Excellent for removing rust, soap scum, stains, grease and hard water minerals. This product is not for use on dishes, glassware or eating utensils.

TO DISINFECT SURFACES LISTED ABOVE:

1. Before disinfecting, thoroughly pre-clean the surfaces according to cleaning directions above.
2. Apply this undiluted product with swab mop, sponge, brush or cloth. Thoroughly wet all surfaces, allow to remain wet for a minimum contact time of 10 minutes.
