


### STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed - call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia. If inhaled - Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated. Get medical attention. If on skin - Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water. Get medical attention, if irritation persists. If in eyes - Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician immediately. NOTE TO PHYSICIAN - Solvent presents aspiration hazard. Abreptine sulfate is antidotal.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling

READ ENTIRE LABEL BEFORE EACH USE.

THIS PRODUCT MUST BE APPLIED USING A COMPRESSED AIR SPRAYER. DO NOT APPLY USING A TRIGGER PUMP SPRAYER.

**INDOOR USE Precautions:** For crack and crevice or spot treatment only. Use only in the areas described. Do not use this product as a fogger or apply it in the air. Do not allow people (especially children) and pets to be, sleep or remain in treated areas during or immediately following treatment and do not allow access until after treated area is dry. Avoid excess application. Dampen surface, but not to the point of saturation or soaking. Upon reentry, immediately open windows and leave area. Keep windows open for at least 2 hours before humans and pets are allowed to remain in the treated area. Do not treat pets or plants with this product. Do not apply directly to carpets or floor coverings and avoid excessive writing on asphalt tile, rubber and plastic materials because damage may occur. Care should be taken to avoid spotting of walls, wall coverings, and fabrics. Do not apply directly to upholstery or furniture. Do not apply to areas, surfaces, or utensils which will contact food or feed. In the home exposed food surfaces should be covered or removed during application. All food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during application and thoroughly washed with soap and water before use. Do not use in edible product areas of food processing plants, restaurants, or other areas where food or feed is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation. Do not use in conduits, motor housings or electrical switch boxes due to the possibility of shock hazard.

### FOR SPOT TREATMENT:

**Indoor Use:** ANTS, COCKROACHES, CRICKETS, SILVERFISH, SPIDERS, SCORPIONS, SAW-TOOTHED GRAIN BEETLES (exposed stage), WATERBUGS: Spray into cracks, crevices around baseboards, and other places where these insects hide. Apply behind and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks, stoves and in and around waste containers.

**For Cracks and Crevices - Apply as follows:** ANTS, COCKROACHES, CRICKETS, SILVERFISH, SOWBUGS, SPIDERS, EARWIGS, BROWN DOG TICKS, FLEAS, CARPET BEETLES, and DERMESTIDS: Apply undiluted spray in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices. Equipment capable of delivering a pin stream should be used in points between elements of construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases where the above listed insects hide. Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces or introducing the material into the air.

**Outdoor Use:** ANTS, CLOVER MITES, CRICKETS, EARWIGS, FLEAS, MILLIPEDES, SOWBUGS, and BROWN DOG TICKS: Spray infested areas thoroughly, including outside surfaces of screens, doors, window frames, foundations, patios, or other places where insects may enter. For ants, spray hills and runways. Repeat as necessary. Do not spray vegetation. Kills: Spiders, Sowbugs, Earwigs, Roaches, Ants, Crickets, Scorpions, Millipedes, Silverfish, Fleas, Saw-Toothed Grain Beetles (exposed stage), Brown Dog Ticks, Clover Mites. Spray residues kill insects many weeks after the spray deposit has dried.

### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

## CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Avoid breathing vapor or spray mist. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Avoid contamination of food or feed. Do not use on household pets or humans. Remove pets from area, and cover fish bowls before spraying.

**ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS** This pesticide is highly toxic to birds, fish, and other wildlife. Do not apply directly to water, to areas where surface water is present, or to intertidal areas below the median high water mark. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or by disposal of equipment washwaters.

**PHYSICAL HAZARDS** Do not use, or store near heat or open flame.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. **STORAGE:** If container is damaged stop any leaks by repositioning the container or by patching or otherwise repairing the leaks. Take care to avoid contact with pesticide and wear protective gear. On cleanup of spilled liquids, wear protective equipment as required to prevent exposure. Clean up spilled areas with generous amounts of absorbent material, such as clay, diatomaceous earth, sand or sawdust. Sweep the contaminated absorbent on to a shovel and put the sweepings into a salvage drum. Dispose of the wastes as below. Place any leaking container into a similar drum or glass as below. Mark the container with name of product, ingredient statement, precautionary statements, and signal word. Do not store, use, pour or spill near heat or flame. **PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL - METAL CONTAINERS:** Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities. **PLASTIC CONTAINERS:** Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
