The following amendment, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable with the conditions listed below:

Proposed Amendment

- Update First Aid Statements per PR Notice 2001-1

Conditions

Revise the label as follows:

1. Delete the phrase "...and similar sites or areas..." from page 2 of the label. Use sites must be specific and this statement is too broad.
2. Delete the Precautionary Statements on page 3 of the label. The Precautionary Statements listed on page 2 of the label are sufficient.


3. Revise the Storage and Disposal section by removing the statement "Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal." from the Pesticide Disposal section and placing it directly following the heading "**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL.**"

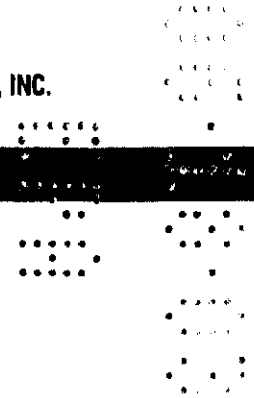
