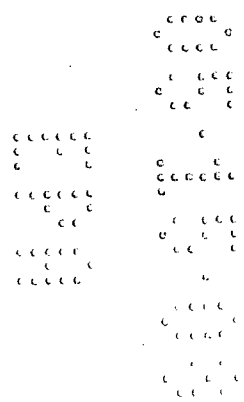

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

**IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT IN A MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELING. RECOMMENDED FOR USE IN SCHOOLS, INSTITUTIONS AND INDUSTRY.**

Remove all dirt and filth before using this product. **NOTE:** Keep tightly closed when not in use. When warm, disinfectant may become cloudy, but will clear up when cooled. This does not impair its efficiency.

**FOR DISINFECTING AGAINST ODOR CAUSING BACTERIA IN TOILET AREAS, SHOWER STALLS, GARBAGE RECEPTACLES, and GARBAGE DISPOSALS:**

Pour 1 part disinfectant into a pail. Add 100 parts of water (4 ounces disinfectant to 12 quarts water). Stir the milky solution before using. Apply solution with a sponge cloth or by mopping. Wet all surfaces thoroughly and allow to stand for 10 minutes, then rinse. Prepare fresh solution after each use.

**FOR DISINFECTING TOILET BOWLS:** Pour 4 ounces of the undiluted disinfectant into bowl water. Swab toilet bowl with the solution completely using a scrub brush or mop, making sure to get under the rim, and let stand for at least 10 minutes. Flush toilet and rinse mop several times. Prepare fresh solution after each use. **FOR SCRUBBING:** Use one 4-ounce cup of disinfectant to a 12 quart pail of water (add water to disinfectant). No rinsing required except on rubber or asphalt tile. Rinse for best shine on no-wax floors. When solution is prepared, prepare only amount needed for job at hand. Discard at end of day or when visibly dirty.

Replace and tighten closures. Tip container on its side and roll it back and forth, ensuring at least one complete revolution, for 30 seconds. Stand the container on its end and tip it back and forth several times. Empty the rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times.

(For containers equal to or less than 5 gallons): Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Offer for recycling, if available. Clean container promptly after emptying. Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank and drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Fill the container 1/4 full with water and recap. Shake for 10 seconds. Pour rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Repeat this procedure two more times.

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
