The label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable.



Do not enter or allow others to enter until sprays have dried. Do not enter or allow others to enter until vapors, mists, and aerosols have dispersed, and the treated area has been thoroughly ventilated. Do not use in commercial food/feed handling establishments, restaurants or other sites where food/feed is commercially prepared, processed, or served. Not for use as a space spray indoors. All outdoor applications must be limited to spot or crack and crevice treatments only, except for the following permitted uses:

1. Applications to underside of eaves, soffits, doors, or windows permanently protected from rainfall by a covering, overhang, awning, or other structure; 2. Applications around potential exterior pest entry points into man-made structures such as doorways and windows, when limited to a band not to exceed one inch; 3. Applications to vertical surfaces (such as the side of a man-made structure) directly above impervious surfaces (e.g., driveways, sidewalks, etc.), up to 2 feet above ground level; 4. Applications to vertical surfaces directly above pervious surfaces, such as soil, lawn, turf, mulch or other vegetation) only if the pervious surface does not drain into ditches, storm drains, gutters, or surface waters. Spot treatments must not exceed two square feet in size (for example, 2ft. by 1 ft or 4 ft. by 0.5 ft.). Do not spray the product into fish pools, ponds, streams, or lakes. Do not apply directly to sewers or storm drains, or to any area like a drain or gutter where drainage to sewers, storm drains, water bodies, or aquatic habitat can occur. Do not allow the product to enter any drain during or after application. Do not apply directly to impervious horizontal surfaces such as sidewalks, driveways, and patios except as a spot or crack-and-crevice treatment. Do not apply or irrigate to the point of runoff. Do not allow to enter indoor or outdoor drains. Follow proper disposal procedures on this label. *No permita la entrada a desagües internos o externos. Siga las indicaciones del etiquetado para el desecho apropiado del producto.*



When used in dairy barns or facilities: Close milk bulk lids to prevent contamination from spray and from dead or falling insects. Remove or cover milking utensils before application. Wash teats of animals before milking. Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift; only protected handlers may be in the area during application. Do not apply within 25 feet of lakes, reservoirs, rivers, permanent streams, marshes or natural ponds, estuaries, and commercial fish farm ponds. For best results, spray in early morning or late evening when insect activity is minimal. Stand a safe distance from nest and not directly underneath.

Remove protective cap. Hold can upright and point spray opening toward nest with wind at your back. Spray until nest is thoroughly saturated to kill the entire nest population. Residual action will kill wasps and hornets returning to the nest. Wait at least 24 hours before removing the nest. To kill wasps, hornets and yellow jackets under eaves, screens, window frames, doors, patios, cracks, holes or crevices wherever insects are noticed, spray for about 1-2 seconds or until surfaces are moist. To prevent entrance of insects into the house, spray around points where insects enter such as outside plumbing, faucets, etc., and cracks or crevices in foundation as well as along sills and ledges. Do not apply to pets or contaminate feed, foodstuffs, dishes or utensils. Avoid spraying vegetation directly.
