Submission: April 27, 1992

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. One copy of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

- 1) For EPA Reg. No. 3870-5, remove the term "Denatured Ethanol" from the ingredient statement and show inert ingredients as 25%.
- 2) Put the PR Notice language for all products under the Directions for Use heading.

Although we still encourage inclusion, we have determined that it is acceptable to exclude the statement from your label, "If you go to a doctor, take this repellent with you". You do not need to submit an amendment to remove this from your label.

We are somewhat doubtful that you will be able to include all of the accepted language onto the back panel of the smaller containers. If you intend on placing some of this language on a blister card, then you must amend your label to indicate this

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change. If you amend your labels in this way, we encourage you to include the most critical warning statements on the label itself.
