DIRECTIONS FOR USE

BETZ Slime-Trol RX-31 aids in the control of objectionable slime-forming microorganisms (bacteria, fungi) in pulp and paper mill systems.

This product should be added directly to the mill system at a rate of 0.1 to 0.5 pound, or 0.011 to 0.054 gallon, per ton of pulp or paper produced. Apply at a point in the system where the product will be uniformly mixed.

This product is toxic to fish and wildlife. Treated effluent should not be discharged where it will drain into lakes, streams, ponds, or public water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as specified on the label.
