This is in response to your letter regarding an additional package size for the subject product.

We have no objection to the marketing of this product in a 16 oz (1 lb) box. Please note that it is not necessary to submit labels for all container sizes when the only difference is the net contents statement.

In the future, please submit an amendment application form when you wish to add another package size/container under this registration. Indicate on the form the size and type of containers you wish to include under this registration. For your convenience, an application form is enclosed.

As indicated per telecon with Ms. Douglas on April 27, 1987, it was noted, in reviewing the file for this registration, that a labeling amendment request filed in August 1977, was never completed. A letter dated September 6, 1977 requested corrected labels. Since these labels (16 oz package) were never submitted we will comment on the labeling submitted with the subject letter (February 12, 1987).

The labeling submitted for the referenced product will be acceptable provided that you make the following labeling changes before you release your product for shipment bearing the amended labels.
