



WACO-50 SPOT FUMIGANT

PRODUCT USE: WACO-50 is for local and spot fumigation to control Bran Bug, Confused Flour Beetle, Red Rust Flour Beetle, Flat Grain Beetle, Saw Toothed Grain Beetle, Indian Meal Moth, Mediterranean Flour Moth, Cadelle, and Certain Other Insects infesting mills and milling equipment.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Treat at monthly intervals or as needed to supplement general fumigations. WACO 50 may be used in the local treatment of equipment.

MILL PREPARATION: Run equipment clean before shutting down for spot fumigation. Do not clean static stock from milling equipment. Eliminate drafts inside milling equipment. Close the connections to dust collectors and seal roof vents. Take all necessary steps to prevent air movement inside the equipment. During application, leave windows open to allow adequate ventilation. Close windows after application.

APPLICATION: WACO 50 is best applied with available application equipment into the equipment through pre-bored, quarter-inch holes. Snap cap fittings are available from Ferguson Fumigants, Inc. to keep holes closed. The average mill is best treated by introducing a four ounce shot into each elevator leg just below the head, and one four-ounce shot into each boot. Sifter sections and roll stands each receive a four ounce shot. Purifiers require 8-14 ounces, depending on the design. Conveyors receive one four-ounce shot every 10-12 feet depending on the size of the conveyor. In addition, dust trunks, dust ers, fan housing cyclones and other equipment should receive four to eight ounces, depending on the size and tightness of construction. Bins and hoppers should receive one four ounce shot per 200 cubic feet of entry space.

AFTER APPLICATION: Close and lock all entrances to the building. Post warning signs on all doors. Post a watchman on the premises. Normal exposure period is 18-24 hours. When exposure is complete, open all doors and windows and aerate the building completely.

During application or re entry of treated areas, wear a full face mask with black canister meeting the specifications of the U.S. Bureau of Mines for Organic Vapors or an airline respirator.

IN CASE OF CONTACT - Remove contaminated clothing, wash skin with soap and water.

IN CASE OF INHALATION - Remove to fresh air. Call a physician immediately. Keep victim lying down and warm. If breathing has stopped, give artificial respiration.

Administer oxygen and caffeine stimulants only under a doctor's supervision.

Do not use fumigated material or feed to livestock until aeration has eliminated the odor of the fumigant.

To prevent decomposition, avoid contact with flame or hot surface. Thermal decomposition may form highly poisonous phosgene gas.

Wash clothing and air shoes thoroughly before re-use. Contact with the bare skin should be avoided. Skin should be washed with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes after contact with fumigant. In case of contact with eyes, flush with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Attention.
