DILUTION CHART**

GAMMENE	WATER
0.6 Fl. Oz. to	1 gallon
3.0 Fl. Oz. to	5 gallons
15.0 Fl. Oz. to	25 gallons
30.0 Fl. Oz. to	50 gallons

Gammene readily mixes with hard or soft water and possesses emulsion stability for a long period. Stir slightly to assure complete suspension of active ingredients.

SUGGESTED USAGE

DOGS: First bathe the animal with soap and water, rinse and towel dry. Mix 1 ounce of Gammene with 1½ gallons of water and apply this emulsion with a sponge or dip the animal, allowing to dry without toweling. (Do not use on cats.)
