DIRECTIONS FOR OUTDOOR USE

Pellent Spray is in liquid form to make it easier for you to impregnate your clothing and outdoor fabrics. When sprayed on skin, one application will repel 2 to 4 hours. Repeat application to exposed skin whenever required.

Pellent sprayed on clothing or fabrics must be wetted to point of saturation. Treating clothing and fabrics with Pellent by normal spraying will give several hours repellency. Dispenser should be held about 6 to 10 inches from fabrics in order to wet them.

An application of Pellent Spray to clothing, canvas and other soft goods does not create any special cleaning or laundering problem — just wash or clean as usual and respray.

To open — Just lift off the cap and press the button. Point spout toward article to be sprayed.

Other Hints for Using Pellent Spray

• Fast 10 second application — Spray on both skin or clothing.

• for hunters and fishermen and outdoor workers . . . apply freely to your clothing, hat, jacket, trouser legs and sox. Golfers do the same.

• Ladies spray on nylon stockings. No more unsightly welts. Does not stain or damage. Spray lightly. Repels several hours.

• for campers, workers - outdoorsmen. Spray tees - bedrolls - and of course clothing.

• To repel chiggers and ticks — be certain to spray all clothing openings such as neck band, trouser cuffs, flaps and belt line. Same for shirts, cuffs, neck and tail.

CAUTION: Keep away from eyes and mouth. Spray on back of hand and wipe on forehead, cheeks, neck and ears. Warning: Contents under pressure.

Do not spray near open fire . . . nor use on animals or plants. Do not store in trunk or glove compartments . . . avoid exposure to hot sun.

Do not puncture or incinerate container.

Do not expose to heat or store at temperatures above 120 degrees.
