This is in response to the above-mentioned amendment. The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Five (5) copies of the finished labeling must be submitted.

1. Under Precautionary Statement, add the phrase "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals."
2. Under Precautionary Statement, delete "Causes skin irritation," "In case of contact, immediately flush skin or eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes," "For eyes get medical attention," and "Do not wear clothing contaminated with this solution."
3. Also, revise the Precautionary Statement to read as follows:

Warning. May be fatal if swallowed. Do not breathe vapors. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing.

4. Add the Statement of Practical Treatment heading and revise accordingly.

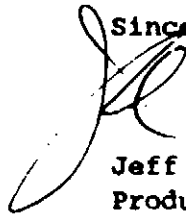
Statement of Practical Treatment

If Swallowed: Drink promptly a large quantity of water. Do not induce vomiting. Avoid alcohol. Get medical attention.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FOR USE IN INDUSTRIAL RECIRCULATING WATER COOLING TOWERS AND AIR WASHERS

ANCO ALGAECIDE NO. 1 is a highly effective fungicide, bactericide and algicide for use in controlling the growth of fungi, bacteria and algae found in industrial recirculating water cooling towers and air washers that maintain effective moist eliminating components.

Dosage for industrial recirculating water cooling towers or air washers will depend on the condition of the system prior to treatment initiation. Systems which are heavily contaminated should be cleaned first. Apply ANCO ALGAECIDE NO. 1 to the cleaned system or when growth is first noticed, according to the following schedule.

Initial Dose: Apply 1-2 quarts of product per each 1000 gallons of water in the system. This dose may be repeated once, twice or three times weekly or as required to control the growth of slime-forming organisms. Slug addition should be made in the pump of water cooling towers.

Subsequent Dose: When microbial control is evident add 1 quart of ANCO ALGAECIDE NO. 1 per 1000 gallons of water in the system every three days or as needed.
