FOR USE IN INDUSTRIAL RECIRCULATION WATER COOLING TOWERS AND AIR WASHERS

ANCOCIDE 4010 is highly effective fungicide, bectericide and algaecide for use in controlling the growth of fungi, bacteris and algae found in industriel recirculating water cooling towers and air washers that maintain effective mist eliminating

Dosage for industrial recirculating water cooling towers or air washers will depend on the condition of the system prior to treatment initiation. Systems which are heavily conteminated should be cleaned first.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS:

Apply AMCOCIDE 4010 to the cleaned system or when growth is first noticed, according to the following achequis:

initial Dose: Apply 1-2 quarts of product per each 1000 gallons of water in the system. This dose may be repeated once, twice or three times westly or as required to control the growth of stime forming organisms. Stug addition should be made in the SUMD of water cooling towers

Subsequent Dose: When microbial control is evident add 1 quest of ANCOCIDE 4010 per 1000 gallons of water in the system every three days or as needed.
