Duro III may be used for a variety of environmental disinfection purposes. It is particularly suited for use as a cold disinfectant bath for instruments and as a topical spray. Duro III will not cause rust. Duro III may be used in mortuaries, hospitals, barber shops, and beauty shops.

Directions for Use

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

As a disinfectant bath for precleaned instruments, add 1 part Duro III to each 5 parts of water required to completely cover instruments in bath. Let instruments remain in solution for at least 10 minutes. Remove, air dry and use. Prepare a fresh solution for each day's use, or more frequently if it becomes soiled or diluted.

As a topical spray, mix 1 part Duro III to each 5 parts of water and use in a mechanical spray device to completely wet precleaned object or surface intended for treatment. Let object or surface remain wet for at least 10 minutes. Let air dry. Intended for use as spray on floors, walls, and fixtures.

1 ounce of Duro III to 5 ounces of water will make 6 ounces of use solution.

Statement of Practical Treatment
