ACTIVE INGREDIENTS:

Isopropenol Methyl Salicylate

n-Alkyl (C₁₄-50%, C₁₂-40%, C₁₆-10%)

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

FOR GENERAL CLEANING AND DISINFECTING: Use 1 cup of disinfectant to 3 gallons of water. Apply to floors, walls, woodwork, desks with a mop or soft brush. For greater efficiency use on previously cleaned surfaces.

FOR TOILET ROOMS: Use 1 cup of disinfectant to 3 gallons of water to wash exterior surfaces of seats, bowls, urinals, bathtubs, floors and baseboards. When used for interior surfaces of commodes and urinals the residual bowl water must be expulsed over the trap before applying the solution.

CUSPIDORS: Use 1 cup of disinfectant in 1½ gallons of water. Wash thoroughly. Leave some solution in each cuspidor to deodorize.

SCHOOLS, FACTORIES, INSTITUTIONS, PUBLIC BUILDINGS: Use a solution of 1 cup of disinfectant in to 3 gallons of water for mopping and spraying all rooms, hallways, stairs and lockers.

FOR GARBAGE CANS AND REFUSE PAILS: To disinfect, remove gross filth and heavy soil deposits before applying a solution of 1 cup disinfectant in 11/2 gallons of water.

FOR RUBBISH PILES AND OUTDOOR CLOSETS: Sprinkle or spray a solution of 1 cup disinfectant in 1½ gallons of water for deodorizing only of these areas.

CAUTION

Harmful if taken internally. Avoid contamination of food. Avoid getting in eyes. Avoid contact with skin. In case of contact, flush with water. If irritation persists, get medical attention. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it.

Do not use, pour, spill or store near heat or open flame.
