- 1. Under the Statement of Practical Treatment, revise the statement "Ingestion: Drink 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting" to read, "If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of water. Avoid alcohol. Do not induce vomiting. Call a physician immediately."
- A minimum contact time of 10 minutes for disinfection 2. must be added to the label.
- Add a statement for removal of the product after the 3. contact time.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records. Submit 5 copies of the final label prior to releasing the product for marketing.
