 \*Includes water, nonionic surfactant, isopropyl alcohol, essential o. methyl salicylate, perfumes and dyes.

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**FOR GENERAL CLEANING AND DISINFECTING:** Use 1 cup of disinfectant to 3 gallons of water. Apply to floors, walls, woodwork, desks with a mop or soft brush. For greater efficiency, use on previously cleaned surfaces. Minimum contact time - 10 minutes for disinfection. No rinse required.

**FOR TOILET ROOMS:** Use 1 cup of disinfectant to 3 gallons of water to wash exterior surfaces of seats, bowls, urinals, bathtubs, floors and baseboards.

When used for interior surfaces of commodes and urinals, the residual bowl water must be expulsed over the trap before applying the solution.

**FOR CUSPIDORS:** Use 1 cup of disinfectant in 1½ gallons of water. Wash thoroughly. Leave some solution in each cuspidor to deodorize.

**FOR SCHOOLS, FACTORIES, PUBLIC BUILDINGS:** Use a solution of 1 cup of disinfectant to 3 gallons of water for mopping and spraying all rooms, hallways, stairs and lockers.

**FOR GARBAGE CANS AND REFUSE PAILS:** To disinfect, remove gross filth and heavy soil deposits before applying a solution of 1 cup disinfectant in 1½ gallons of water.

**FOR RUBBISH PILES AND OUTDOOR CLOSETS:** Sprinkle or spray solution of 1 cup disinfectant in 1½ gallons of water to deodorize any of these areas.
