DIRECTIONS FOR USE

In making solutions, always add water to the dirintectart.

For maximum efficiency, apply the disinfectant solution, to previously cleaned surfaces.

FOR GENERAL DISINFECTING AND CLEANING PURPOSES inhotels, motels, schools, offices, stores, factories, etc. Use 100 parts water to 1 part of the disinfectant. Never use boiling water - lukewarm water gives the best results.

The general use dilution of 100 parts water to 1 part of disinfectant can be used for disinfecting sick rooms and sick room utensils, for washing telephone and dictating machine mouth pieces, for cleaning and deodorizing outdoor closets and garbage receptacles. Listed below are a few specific applications.

FLOORS: For scrubbing or mopping, use 1/2 cupful disinfectant to each pail of water.

URINALS AND TOILETS: Use 2 1/2 oz. disinfectant to each gallon of water. Apply freely to all surfaces to be disinfected and flush the drain pipes with the solution for deodorization.

CAUTION

Do not reuse empty drum. Return to drum reconditioner or destroy by perforating or crushing and burying in a safe place.

This disinfectant may cause skin irritation on some persons allergic to this type of compound. It is recommended only for application to inanimate objects. This disinfectant is not to be used as an antiseptic on the human body. Avoid contact of solutions of this disinfectant with the skin. If spilled on the skin, flood affected parts with water immediately. Harmful if swallowed.
