## Dear Ms. Campbell:

The following amendment submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable with the conditions listed below.

Update First Aid Statements per PR Notice 2001-1

## **Conditions**

### Revise the label as follows:

- 1. Based on substantially similar products in the market, you must update your "Precautionary Statements" to read "Causes moderate eye irritation. Harmful if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Do not breathe spray mist. Wash throughly with soap and water after handling. Avoid contact with foods."
- 2. According to PR Notice 2001-1, the "Note to the Physician" text is required on products that are categorized as for primary eye and skin irritation. Since this products eye and skin irritation profile is category III, delete the "Note to the Physician" language.
- 3. Under the "Directions for Use," you will need to qualify tiles and porcelain as hard non-porous by stating "glazed tiles" and "glazed porcelain"
- 4. Revise the "For Cleaning" heading to state "For Cleaning and Deodorizing."

- 5. Revise the Disinfecting directions to state "Pre-clean hard, non-porous surfaces. Spray until thoroughly wet. Let stand 10 minutes, then remove excess liquid."
- 6. Since this product is only sold in containers less than 1 gallon, revise the "Storage and Disposal" statements to reflect the following:

Store at temperature below 120oF. Do not store indirect sunlight near sources of heat. Do not puncture or incinerate. Discard in trash.

## **General Comments**

A stamped copy of the labeling accepted with conditions is enclosed. Submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling before distributing or selling the product bearing the revised labeling.

### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZAROS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful If swallowed. Avoid breathing vapors. Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing. Avoid contamination of food and feedstuff.

**FIRST AID**

### DIRECTIONS

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Shake well to get a heavy foam that will not run. Hold container as upright as possible when spraying.

Use in bathroom to clean, deodorize and disinfect surfaces such as counters and table tops, plastic surfaces, basins, bathtubs, shower stalls, grouting, tiles, porcelain enamel or metal surfaces.

FOR CLEANING: Spray evenly over soiled surface. Wipe clean. For heavy soil, allow to remain a minute before wiping.

FOR DISINFECTING: Spray evenly over cleaned surface and allow to remain 10 minutes before wiping.

STORAGE: Store at temperatures below 120°F. Do not store in direct sunlight or near sources of heat. Do Not Puncture or Incineratel
