The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
  - a. The front panel signal word DANGER must be in the correct type size.
  - b. Expand the Environmental Hazard statement to read as follows:

This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not discharge effluent containing this active ingredient into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans, or public waters unless this product is specifically identified and addressed in an NPDES permit. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA.

- c. We have determined that this product is subject to Child Resistant Packaging regulations (effective March 9, 1981). Refer to 40 CFR 163.16 "Pesticides Requiring Special Packaging"

However, you may wish to voluntarily restrict your product to use by service persons only which would not require child resistant packaging. To do this, you must print on the label, or temporarily apply as a sticker on the label or on the container for all sizes in which this product will be marketed, the following statement:

Only for Sale To, Use and Storage by Service Personnel.


This statement must be at least the same type size as the child hazard warning statement and preferably placed in the upper front panel.

- 2. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
