To prepare coefficient 5 disinfectant add one volume of water to an equal volume of disinfectant with gentle agitation. Avoid prolonged standing in open container as loss of volatile constituents may result.

Directions for use of the resulting disinfectant should not recommend dilution of greater than 1 part to 20 multiplied by the phenol coefficient for effective disinfectant ie (1 part Coef. 5 to 20 x 5 or 100 parts water).

WARNING

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Causes eye or skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.
