

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

CAUTION

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. May be harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing of spray mist and provide adequate ventilation of area being treated. Contact with skin, eyes or clothing should be avoided.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

EYES: Flush with water for 15 minutes and call a physician.
SKIN: Wash thoroughly with soap and water. Seek medical attention if irritation persists.
INGESTION: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Do not induce vomiting because of possible aspiration hazard. Seek medical aid immediately.

NOTE to physician: Atropine Sulfate is antidotal.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife. Do not apply directly to water. Do not apply where runoff is likely to occur. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Do not use as a Space Spray. Do not use in edible product areas of food processing plants, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed. Do not use, pour, spill or store near heat or open flame. Do not apply this product in conduits, motor housings, junctions, and switch boxes or other electrical equipment because of possible shock hazard. 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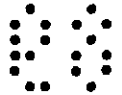

DIRECTIONS

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. To control most weeds and grasses for extended periods on non-cropland areas such as industrial plant sites, parking lots, loading ramps and around storage buildings, apply 1 to 4 gallons of product per 1000 square feet after the most predominant weeds have emerged. No agitation is required. Can be applied with standard spray equipment. For treating small areas, a tank type hand sprayer or sprinkling can can be used.

NOTE: Users should consult State Agricultural Experiment Stations or Extension Service Weed Specialists for recommendations as to use in their particular area or contact your distributor.

IMPORTANT: Do not apply directly to, or otherwise permit this liquid to contact susceptible plants as this product may injure cotton, beans, peas, grapes, fruit trees, ornamentals or other desirable plants. Avoid spray drift to such susceptible plants (coarse sprays are less likely to drift.) Vapors from this product may injure susceptible plants in the immediate vicinity. Do not apply to areas underlaid by roots of desirable trees and shrubs. Do not store near fertilizers, seeds, insecticides or fungicides. Thoroughly clean spray equipment with a suitable chemical cleaner before using for other purposes (or do not use same equipment for other purposes.) Do not re-use this container.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep pesticide in original container. Do not put concentrate or dilute into food or drink containers. Do not contaminate feed, foodstuffs or drinking water. Do not store or transport near feed or food. Store at temperatures above 32°F.
