The basic confidential statement of formula referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. A copy has been included in the product jacket for this registration and supercedes all previous basic formulations.

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. One copy of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

In accordance with the Resmethrin registration standard, the active ingredient should be listed as Resmethrin, and the chemical name must be deleted.

Delete the footnote "Contains petroleum distillates." The confidential statement of formula does not include any petroleum distillates.

Add to the Precautionary Statements the following:
 Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling.

Delete the ingestion statement from the statement of practical treatment and substitute the following:
 If Swallowed: Call a physician or poison control center.

Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. If person is unconscious, do not give anything by mouth and do not induce vomiting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:
**SPRAY ONLY ON HARD SUR-
FACES. DO NOT USE AS A SPACE
SPRAY.** It is a violation of federal law
to use this product in a manner in-
consistent with its labeling.

This formulation may be used as a con-
tact spray against crawling insects. As
a residual insecticide, it will provide up
to 3 to 4 weeks of control of roaches.
Shake well before use. Remove protec-
tive cap. Aim spray opening away from
person. Push button to spray.

**ROACHES, EARWIGS, GRAINMITES,
Sow bugs, SPIDERS and CENTI-
PEDES: CONTACT SPRAY:** Spray
thoroughly into hiding places such as
cracks, crevices, moist areas, openings
around pipes and sinks, under refrigera-
tors, baseboards and storage areas.
Spray directly on insects where pos-
sible. Repeat as necessary.

RESIDUAL SPRAY: Spray base-
boards, cracks and crevices, around
door and window frames and other hid-
ing places such as closets, in back of
and under appliances, sinks and cup-
boards in the kitchen and bathroom. In
basements, spray hiding places in
cracks and crevices, lower walls and
dark places. Spray at the rate of 3 to 4
seconds per linear foot at a distance 12
to 14 inches from the surface. Repeat
as necessary. **ANTS:** Apply to ant trails
and around door sills, window frames
and other places where ants may enter.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Do not store in direct sun-
light. Store at temperatures below
120°F. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Do not
reuse empty container. Replace cap,
wrap in paper and discard containers in
trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
