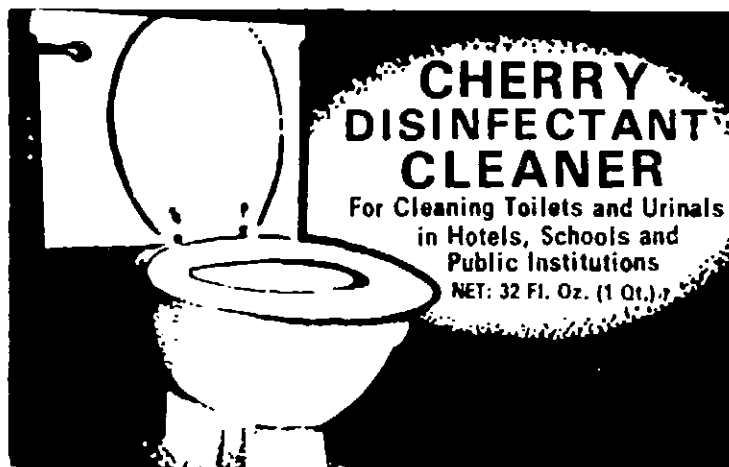

FOR CLEANING AND DISINFECTING OF TOILET BOWLS

First remove water from bowl by forcing over trap with bowl mop, then remove water from mop by pressing against side of bowl. Holding bottle over bowl, pour directly on bowl mop until saturated. Swab all parts of bowl thoroughly and especially under rim. Flush bowl and rinse mop. After cleaning and flushing, pour 3 to 5 ounces into the bowl water. Swab entire bowl seat and cover thoroughly, then flush bowl again.

FOR CLEANING AND DISINFECTING URINALS
Holding bottle over urinal, pour directly on bowl mop until saturated. Swab all surfaces of urinal, water outlets at top and all grooves. Remove drain screen and pour 4 to 6 ounces around and into drain pipe. Let stand for 2 or 3 minutes, then mop drain thoroughly, replace drain screen and flush urinal.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: This product must be kept in locked storage sufficient to make it inaccessible to children or persons unfamiliar with its proper use.

DISPOSAL: To dispose of this product, neutralize in an earthen pit with lime or limestone away from water supplies. Rinse this container thoroughly with water before discarding.

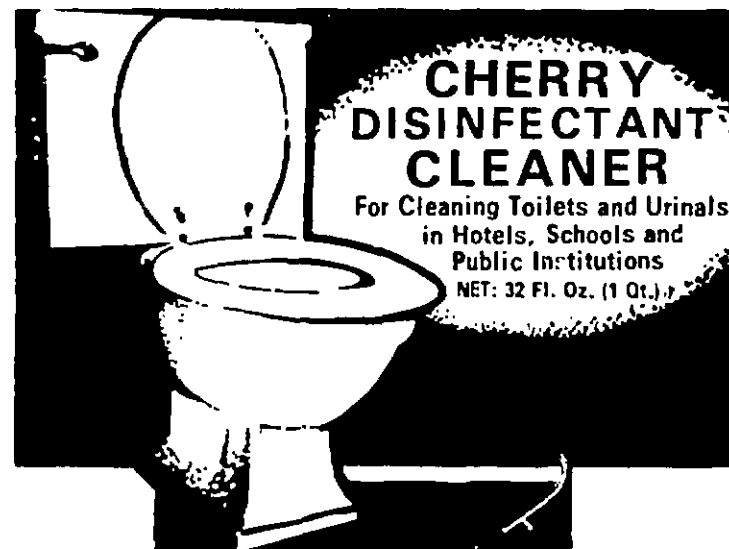
