HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

CAUTION

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

Harmful if swallowed. Do not breathe vapors or fumes. May cause skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Rubber gloves and goggles or face shield should be worn during mixing or pouring of this product.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

FIRST AID PROCEDURES

EYES: Flush with water for 15 minutes and call a physician.

SKIN: Wipe off the acid gently, immediately wash with soap and water then cover with moist magnesia or baking soda.

INGESTION: Call a physician immediately. Drink a teaspoonful or more of milk of magnesia or a cup of soapy water followed with milk or raw egg whites.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product could be hazardous to aquatic life in concentrated form.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Do not mix with chlorine type bleaches or other household chemicals. This cleaner is inhibited to prevent harm to pipes and drains. It should not be used on finished surfaces other than toilet bowls or urinals. If used on surfaces other than vitreous ware, the user must assume all risk.

DIRECTIONS

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FOR CLEANING AND DISINFECTING OF TOILET BOWLS: First remove water from bowl by forcing over trap with bowl mop, then remove water from mop by pressing against side of bowl. Holding bottle over bowl, pour directly on bowl mop until saturated. Swab all parts of bowl thoroughly and especially under rim. Flush bowl and rinse mop. After cleaning and flushing, pour 3 to 5 ounces into the bowl water. Swab entire bowl seat and cover thoroughly, then flush bowl again.

FOR CLEANING AND DISINFECTING URINALS: Holding bottle over urinal, pour directly on bowl mop until saturated. Swab all surfaces of urinal water outlets at top and all grooves. Remove drain screen and pour 4 to 8 ounces around and into drain pipe. Let stand for 2 to 3 minutes, then mop drain thoroughly, replace drain screen and flush urinal.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep product in original container. Do not put concentrate or dilute into food or drink containers. Do not contaminate feed, foodstuffs or drinking water. Do not store or transport near feed or food. Store at temperatures above 32° F.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by State and local authorities.
