Pyhenone*-Type Household Spray contains pyrethrins and piperonyl butoxide. It is an effective insecticide for rapid control of insect pests found in homes, schools, hospitals, institutions and public buildings. It can be used around food, food products and utensils, according to directions, without danger of contamination, but naturally should not be applied directly to uncovered food or foodstuffs. Safeticide Brand Repellant can be used in all spray guns or atomizer dispensers adjusted to deliver a fine mist.

DIRECTIONS:

ANIMALS: Safeticide Brand Repellent protects animals such as cattle, horses, pigs and dogs for 24 hours against biting flies such as horse flies, horn flies, house flies, stable flies. When spraying animals, apply only as a mist spray, using not more than two (2) ounces on cattle, horses or pigs. On dogs mist spray not more than one (1) ounce.

FOR CATTLE: Daily use, after milking, will protect dairy cattle from the discomforts and annoyances of biting flies, which often decrease milk production and weight gain. Cover the animal with spray, with particular attention to back, flanks and legs. Do not soak the skin or wet the hide.

FOR HORSES: Spray lightly or sponge horses, using 1 or 2 ounces per adult animal, proportionately less for smaller animals. Give special attention to shanks, legs and shoulders. Apply till hair is moistened, but do not soak hide. **FOR PIGS:** Spray lightly where flies congregate. Repeat as needed.

KENNELS: When spraying for flies and ticks around Kennels and Dog Pounds, spray SAFETICIDE BRAND REPELLANT in and around animals' sleeping quarters, up the walls and all over the floors. In the control of FLYING INSECTS, (as listed above), direct the spray toward the upper portions of the enclosure and fill the atmosphere with mist using 2 or 3 ounces to each 1,000 cubic feet of space.

In treating fleas, spraying should include treatment of floors and animal sleeping quarters, along with a light mist spray on the animal. Against RUNNING AND CRAWLING INSECT PESTS, (as listed above), treat all areas where these insects are commonly found, and direct the liquid behind baseboards, moldings, furniture, cabinets, shelves, sinks and pipes; toward drains and dark corners, and into cracks, crevices, recesses and similar hiding places. In spraying for carpet beetles, you should include treatment of floors, carpeting and cracks in baseboards. In spraying for clothes moths, treatment should include spraying of the clothing, clothing receptacles every 30 days unless clothing is stored in moth-proof containers. When spraying for clothes moths and carpet beetles, pay particular attention to seams and folds. In spraying for bedbugs, treatment should include spraying of bed, mattresses and hiding places. Repeat when necessary. Use product as a space spray in food processing plants only when plant is not in operation. Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered or thoroughly cleaned before using.
