DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product is recommended for use in schools, hospitals, restrooms, motels.

FOR GENERAL DISINFECTING: Preclean all surfaces prior to disinfection.

Dilute 7 1/2 oz. of Pine Type "B" Disinfectant to a gallon of water.

Apply with sponge, mop or cloth and wet all surfaces thoroughly. Allow 10 minutes of contact time for proper effectiveness. This product does not have to be removed after the recommended exposure period.

A fresh solution should be prepared for each use.

FOR DISINFECTION OF TOILET BOWLS: Preclean all surfaces prior to disinfection.

Flush and add product directly to bowl water (6 oz. or 3/4 cup). Scrub the bowl using a scrub brush or mop, making sure to get under the rim, and let stand for at least 10 minutes, then flush.

CAUTION: HARMFUL IF SWALLOWED. KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.

Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Avoid contamination of food. In case of ingestion call physician immediately.

STORAGE:

Store in original containers only. If container is damaged or is leaking transfer to a clean never used container. Mop up spill and dispose of on site in trash.

Avoid cross-contamination with other products water, food or feed. Keep in locked storage area.

Store temperature 40°F - 80°F

DISPOSAL:

Triple rinse (or equivalent) the container. Then offer for recycling or reconditioning or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.
