

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

**DIPPING:** Soaking is the most effective method of protection. For best results, soak wood for 12 to 24 hours, depending on thickness of wood.

**BRUSHING:** Apply at least 12 liberal coats for long-lasting protection; allow to dry overnight between coats. When treated lumber is cut, apply 2 coats to the exposed, untreated wood.

**NOTE:** Fence posts are best treated with full length coverage, but should have at least 10 inches of treated wood above ground when setting posts. DO NOT thin or mix with any other product.
