DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Use this combination insecticide-fungicide at the rate of 20 lbs. per acre at intervals of 10 to 14 days (oftener if washed off by rain) for the control of thrip, leafhopper, armyworm and leafspot on peanuts. Begin applications when the first spots appear on the basal leaves (usually 60-65 days after planting). NOTE: Do not use with lime or other alkaline material. CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. Do not take internally. Avoid breathing dust. Avoid prolonged or repeated contact with skin. Wash thoroughly after handling. Change contaminated clothing daily. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs.

NOTE FOR PHYSICIAN: Carbaryl is a moderate reversible, Cholinesterase, inhibitor. Atrophine is antidotal.
