DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Use this combination insecticide-fungicide for the control of thrip, leafhopper, armyworm and leafspot on peanuts at the rate of 20 to 30 lbs. per acre at 7 to 10 day intervals (oftener if washed off by rain). Begin applications when insects appear or when first spots appear on the basal leaves. NOTE: Do not use with lime or other alkaline material.

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. Do not take internally. Avoid breathing dust. Avoid prolonged or repeated contact with skin. Wash thoroughly after handling. Change contaminated clothing daily. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs.

NOTE FOR PHYSICIAN: Carbaryl is a moderate reversible, Cholinesterase, inhibitor. Atrophine is antidotal.
