PEANUTS—For Control of Thrips and Leafhopper.

Thrips. Apply at the rate of 20 lbs. per acre using a regular duster with nozzles directly over the Peanut plants. One dusting phication usually gives satisfactory control. Apply about the first or second week in June, or as soon as injury is first observed.

May be applied up to and including the day of harvest.

Leafhopper. Apply dust at the rate of 20 lbs. per acre, using regular duster with nozzles directly over the Peanut plants. Two applications, approximately two weeks apart, usually needed. The first application should be made about the middle of July, or as soon as injury is first observed, and a second application should be made about the first of August. Additional applications may be made until the day of harvest.

TOBACCO—For the Control of Hornworms, Budworms, Flea Beetles, June Beetles and Jacanese Beetles.

Applications should begin at the first sign of insect or their damage. Apply formulation at the rate of 25 lbs. per acre. Repeat application as needed. Do Not apply within three days of priming or cutting. Avoid excessive applications. If late season applications are necessary, treat immediately after priming rather than before priming.
