For preserving wood, treat joints of the foundation. In a dry wood, and in a wet foundation wood, and 12 to 48 hours. It is an effective wood preservative.

Lighter lumber and piping can be treated by immersion for at least 5 minutes per inch thickness of wood. The treatment will be. This solution may be applied generously and recommended. Surfaces treated.

For soil poisoning against termites, dig a trench 6" to 12" deep and fill with concrete. Constructing the trench. This is to be treated at the rate of 4 gallons per foot depth. For example, a trench 3 feet deep will hold at least 3 feet away from trees and shrubs or plants.

PENTA TREET is a ready to use solution of pentachlorophenol used for wood preservation. It is used in preserving wood that comes into contact with the ground and in poisoning the soil around the foundations of buildings. The pentachlorophenol kills termites and wood destroying fungi. Do not dilute this product. Do not use it on surfaces that are intended to be painted.

For preserving wood: For posts, pilings, foundation timbers, and heavy wood framing, wood must be clean, dry, well-seasoned, and free of rotten wood and bark. Immerse in the 5% solution for a period of 12 to 48 hours for an effective wood preserver.

Lighter lumber and painting can be treated by immersing the clean, dry, rot-free wood in an open tank for at least 5 minutes per inch thickness of wood. The longer the immersion, the more effective the treatment will be. This solution may be applied by paint brush or by spray application. Two generous coats are recommended. Surfaces treated with this solution are not paintable.

For soil poisoning against termites: Dig a trench along the outside of the foundation wall. If brick, hollow block, or concrete construction, dig the trench to, but not below, the footing. Then, as the trench is refilled, treat the soil at the rate of 4 gallons of the 5% solution per 10 linear feet for each foot of depth. For example, a trench 3 feet deep would require 12 gallons per 10 linear feet. Keep at least 3 feet away from trees and shrubs or protect with tarpaper.

The objective of soil poisoning is to establish a treated soil barrier which will prevent termite entry. Other critical areas may require treatment. Consult the State Extension Service for advice.
