



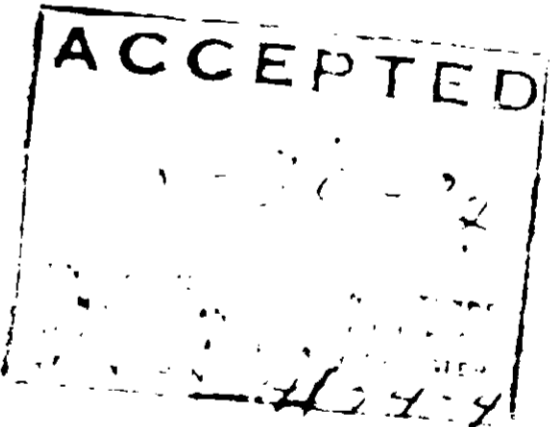

## PENTA-CONCENTRATE

PENTA-CONCENTRATE is a liquid to be diluted to a ready-to-use solution containing 5% by weight of pentachlorophenol. Mix one part of Penta-Concentrate with 10 parts by volume of water to obtain a 5% solution. This 5% solution is used for both preserving wood against decay and rot, including fungi, and for soil poisoning against termites.

For preserving wood: Fence posts, poles, foundation timbers, and heavy wooden members must be clean, dry, well-seasoned, and free of rotten wood and bark. Immerse in the 5% solution for a period of 12 to 48 hours to be an effective wood preserver.

Lighter timbers and planking can be treated by immersing the clean, dry softwood in the 5% solution for at least 5 minutes per inch thickness of wood. The longer the immersion, the more effective the treatment will be. This solution may be applied by paint brush or by spray application. The general use is recommended. Surfaces treated with this solution are not paintable.

For soil poisoning against termites: Dig a trench along the outside of the foundation walls. In brick or hollow block or concrete construction, dig the trench to, but not below, the footing. Then, as the trench is refilled, treat the soil at the rate of 4 gallons of the 5% solution per 10 linear feet for each foot of depth. For example, a trench 3 feet deep would require 12 gallons per 10 linear feet. Keep at least 3 feet away from trees and bushes or protect with tarp paper.

The objective of soil poisoning is to create a toxic soil barrier which will prevent termite entry. Other methods may be required. Consult the State Extension Service for advice.

To avoid damage to fish and wildlife: Do not contaminate water by cleaning equipment or disposing of wastes. Apply this product only as permitted on this label.

Do not use in residential areas. Destroy when empty.
