The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable, provided that you:

1. Have the label in question revised to read:
 - a. On the side panel, expand the statement "KILLS HUMAN IMMUNODEFICIENCY VIRUS TYPE 1 (HIV-1) (AIDS VIRUS) ON PRECLEANED ENVIRONMENTAL SURFACES/OBJECTS PREVIOUSLY SOILED WITH BLOOD/BODY FLUIDS" to read "KILLS HIV ON PRE-CLEANED ENVIRONMENTAL SURFACES/OBJECTS PREVIOUSLY SOILED WITH BLOOD/BODY FLUIDS in health care settings (Hospitals, Nursing Homes) or other settings in which there is an expected likelihood of soiling of inanimate surfaces/objects with blood or body fluids, and in which the surfaces/objects likely to be soiled with blood or body fluids can be associated with the potential for transmission of human immunodeficiency virus Type 1 (HIV-1) (associated with AIDS.)"
 - b. On the left side panel, above the word "DANGER," include the following statement to read:

Precautionary Statements
 hazards to humans and Domestic Animals


- c. Delete the word "milk."
 - d. Under the "Note to Physician" heading, delete the last sentence beginning with "Measures against circulatory shock"
 - e. Include the subheadings:
 - Pesticide Disposal.
 - Container Disposal.
 - f. Revise "a pre-cleaning step is recommended" to read "a pre-cleaning step is required."
 - g. Revise "See direction panel for additional precautionary and practical treatment statements" to read "See side panel for additional precautionary statements."
2. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.
