DESCRIPTION
This product is a cleaner/disinfectant designed for institutional and industrial cleaning. For use on walls, floors and other hard, nonporous, inanimate surfaces. When used as directed, it will also deodorize those areas which generally are hard to keep fresh smelling, such as GARBAGE PAILS, SINK TOPS, AND BATHROOM AREAS which are prone to odors caused by the growth of some microorganisms. At 2 ounces per gallon, this product is effective against *Staphylococcus aureus*, *Salmonella choleraesuis*, *fungicide* against *Trichophyton florescens* (pathogenic fungi), and deodorizer. At 3 ounces per gallon of water, it is an effective hospital disinfectant against *Pseudomonas aeruginosa*.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE
It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. This product has been designed to provide effective cleaning, deodorizing, sanitization, and disinfection specifically for hospitals, nursing homes, schools, food service establishments, and other institutions where housekeeping is of prime importance in controlling the hazard of cross contamination.

VIRUCIDAL: KILLS HIV ON PRECLEANED ENVIRONMENTAL SURFACES/OBJECTS PREVIOUSLY SOILED WITH BLOOD/BODY FLUIDS In health care settings or other settings in which there is an expected likelihood of soiling of inanimate surfaces/objects with blood or body fluids, and in which the surfaces/objects likely to be soiled with blood or body fluids can be associated with the potential for transmission of human immunodeficiency virus Type 1 (HIV-1) (associated with AIDS).

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR CLEANING AND DECONTAMINATION AGAINST HIV-1 OF SURFACES/OBJECTS SOILED WITH BLOOD/BODY FLUIDS:

PERSONAL PROTECTION: Specific barrier protection items to be used when handling items soiled with blood or body fluids are disposable latex gloves, gowns, masks, or eye shields.

CLEANING PROCEDURE: Blood and other body fluids must be thoroughly cleaned from surfaces and objects before application of this product.

CONTACT TIME: Leave surfaces wet for 10 minutes.

DISPOSAL OF INFECTIOUS MATERIALS: Blood and other body fluids should be collected and disposed of according to federal, state, and local regulations for infectious waste disposal.

TO CLEAN AND DEODORIZE GARBAGE STORAGE AREAS, EMPTY GARBAGE BINS AND CANS, TOILET BOWLS: Use 3 ounces per gallon and apply to wet surfaces thoroughly with mop, cloth, sponge, or mechanical sprayer. Allow to remain wet for 10 minutes and then let air dry. For heavy soil, a pre-cleaning step is required before using. Prepare a fresh solution for each use.

DISINFECTION: To disinfect hard, inanimate surfaces, apply solution with a mop, cloth, sponge or mechanical sprayer to 2.5% OAC of surface thoroughly. Allow to remain wet for 10 minutes.

GENERAL DISINFECTANT: Add 2 ounces of this product per gallon of water. For heavily soiled areas a pre-cleaning step is required. Prepare a fresh solution for each use.

DANGER

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes call a physician. Remove and wash all contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of egg whites, gelatin solution or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid stools. Call a physician immediately.
